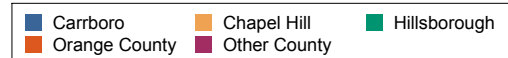
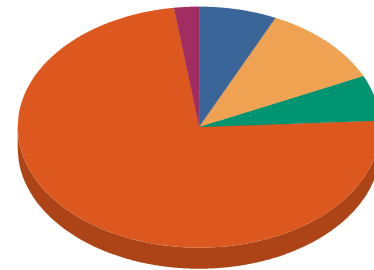

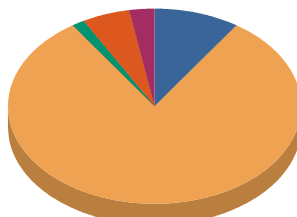

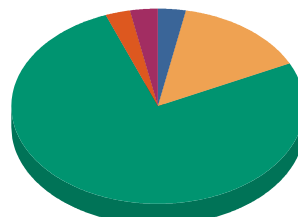
## Animal and Outcome Type



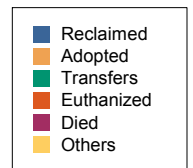
