**NORTH CAROLINA STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT ALL PLASTIC DRINK BOTTLES AND ALUMINUM CANS BE RECYCLED!**

**CORRUGATED CARDBOARD IS BANNED FROM YOUR GARBAGE!**

**THIS IS CORRUGATED CARDBOARD AND MUST BE RECYCLED:  BUT NOT IN YOUR BLUE CARTS.**

Recycle pizza boxes if they are free of cheese – a little bit of grease is OK. See your manager about cardboard recycling. More often than not, there is a cardboard dumpster on-site.

**DO NOT LEAVE PLASTIC BAGS OR GARBAGE IN YOUR RECYCLING CART!**

If you collect recyclables in a plastic bag, remove them from the bag before depositing them in your recycling cart. Discard the bag elsewhere. Clean, dry plastic grocery bags can be reused or recycled at many grocery stores but not in your recycling carts.

**ONLY PLACE ITEMS PICTURED ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THIS CARD IN YOUR RECYCLING CART.**

**RIGID PLASTIC** tubs, cups and other non-bottle rigid plastics #2, #4, #5 ONLY can be recycled in the blue carts. No clear plastic clamshells or Styrofoam. Large rigid plastic items such as buckets and toys can be taken to a Solid Waste Convenience Center.

**DRINK BOXES and CARTONS** can now be recycled in the blue cart.

**LEAVE YOUR CAP ON!** Flatten empty plastic bottles, replace cap, then recycle.

**OTHER WASTE REDUCTION OPPORTUNITIES:**

Recycle at Orange County Solid Waste Convenience Centers:

- Electronics • All Batteries • Motor Oil • Antifreeze • Oil Filters

Bring hazardous household waste such as paint, pesticides and fluorescent lights to the HHW collection facility at the Orange County Landfill, 1514 Eubanks Road in Chapel Hill, or the Walnut Grove Church Rd. Solid Waste Convenience Center.
