CLIMAX	Early ripening	-Medium size berries; sweet flavor -Upright growth with intense green foliage -One of the very best for harvesting
PREMIER	Early to mid-season ripening	-Large, light blue, good quality fruit; excellent flavor -Highly productive, upright growth, good foliage
POWDER BLUE	Late season ripening	-Medium to large size fruit, darker blue in color; sweet taste - Upright highly productive plant, good foliage

These blueberry plants are grown in Eastern North Carolina and the varieties available for purchase include: **Climax, Premier and Powder Blue**. It is recommended that two or more varieties of blueberries be planted together for pollination and to



assure higher yields and better quality fruit. Cross Pollination will help increase production; the actual yield will also be partially dependent upon size and vigor of the plant. See the below variety description of early season production to late season. Plants are 3 years old and vary in size from 16” to 20” in height. You will receive fruit within the first year of planting – Instant gratification!

Blueberry growing tips and soils prep information will be provided to you at time of plant pickup.
