## How to Play:

- 1) Pick up a log sheet from a circulation desk at any of our branches.
- 2) This challenge has three levels. Levels **must** be checked off in order, but you may work on multiple levels at the same time.
- 3) To complete a level, do at least 7 of the 12 tasks listed. Library staff are happy to help you find books that meet specific task requirements!
- 4) You may count one book for multiple reading tasks, or read one book per task.
- 5) After finishing each level, bring your log sheet to the library, ask a staff member to initial it, and **pick up your prize!**

## Level One:

- Ask us how to sign up for a library card, or update your existing account.
- Bring a friend to the library for a new library card or a program.

- Read an e-book or e-audiobook downloaded from NC Homegrown E-books or rbDigital (both available through NC LIVE).

- Attend a library program for adults during Summer Learning.
- Recommend a book that you've read this summer to a friend or family member.
- Use our Summer Learning hashtags ([#SummerofSpace](#), [#OCPLSummer2019](#), [#OCPLGrownup2019](#)) to tell us what you're reading on social media.
- Read a science fiction novel.
- Read an epistolary novel or a collection of letters.
- Read a book that you've been meaning to read but haven't gotten around to yet.
- Read a book that won a literary award in 2018.
- Read a book of poetry or a novel in verse.
- Read a travel memoir.
- Read a book in translation.

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## Level Three:

- Listen to a book-themed podcast that is new to you.

- Buddy-read a book with a friend, family member, or coworker and discuss it.
- Judge a book by its cover: read a book with a cover you love.
- Try not to judge a book by its cover: read a book with a cover you hate.
- Listen to an audiobook nominated for an Audie award in the last 5 years.
- Read a book set in your hometown or a place where you have lived.
- Read a book from a series that is at least 5 books long.

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
