- Purchase/use reusable shopping bags
- Reuse glass/plastic containers for storage

Recycle Materials

- Plastic recycled (Plastic bags elsewhere?)
- Cans, aluminum, recycled
- Cardboard
- Glass recycled
- Paper recycled

Compost

- Food scraps
- Small bits of paper
- Packaging/products made of compostable material
