

Family Success Alliance

The Family Success Alliance is modeled after successful initiatives such as the Harlem Children's Zone and Promise Neighborhoods.

Our work is currently focusing on two community areas of Orange County which we call zones.

Zone 4 is located centrally in the county between I-40 and I-85 and includes A.L. Stanback Middle and New Hope Elementary Schools.

Zone 6 is located in the densely populated area which includes downtown Chapel Hill southwest to Highway 54 and includes Carrboro Elementary, Frank Porter Graham, and Northside Elementary Schools.

Zone Navigators

One of the incredible features of Family Success Alliance is the Zone Navigator. We have 4 Navigators, 3 of whom are bilingual. Navigators serve as a connection between families and resources. They are the primary link between the Family Success Alliance and families.
