


**Animal Control Activities by Jurisdiction**



| Fowl                        | 8          | 2%          |
| Wildlife                    | 7          | 2%          |
| Other                       | 5          | 1%          |
| Rabies Vectors <sup>2</sup> | 50         | 12%         |

**Animal Control Activities by Call Type**

|---|------------|-------------|
| <b>Assistance:</b> AC assistance provided to other agencies                                   | 13         | 3%          |
| <b>Bite:</b> Investigations of bites to humans by dogs, cats, ferrets                         | 100        | 23%         |
| <b>Canvass:</b> AC dissemination of information to the public                                 | 20         | 5%          |
| <b>Confiscate:</b> Animal impounds due to legal order violation, cruelty, investigation       | 0          | 0%          |
| <b>Cruelty:</b> Investigations of animal cruelty  | 35         | 8%          |
| <b>Exposure:</b> Investigations of animals, people exposed to rabies vector species           | 42         | 10%         |
| <b>Kennel:</b> Inspections of permitted kennels in Orange County                              | 0          | 0%          |
| <b>Nuisance:</b> Investigations of animals creating a public nuisance                         | 37         | 9%          |
| <b>Other:</b> Activities that do not fall into other categories                               | 40         | 9%          |
| <b>Owned:</b> Activities related to owned animals (e.g. surrenders)                           | 6          | 1%          |
| <b>Protective Custody:</b> Animals impounded due to owners inability to provide care          | 2          | 0%          |
| <b>Stray:</b> Activities related to stray animals (animals without owners, off property, etc) | 70         | 16%         |
| <b>Tethering:</b> Activities related to a tethered animal                                     | 9          | 2%          |
| <b>Trap:</b> Activities related to the trapping of an animal                                  | 41         | 9%          |
| <b>Wildlife:</b> Activities related to wildlife species                                       | 19         | 4%          |
| <b>Total</b>  | <b>434</b> | <b>100%</b> |
