





<b>Bite:</b> Investigations of bites to humans by dogs, cats, ferrets	68	15%
<b>Canvass:</b> AC dissemination of information to the public	13	3%
<b>Confiscate:</b> Animal impounds due to legal order violation, cruelty, investigation	0	0%
<b>Cruelty:</b> Investigations of animal cruelty	44	10%
<b>Exposure:</b> Investigations of animals, people exposed to rabies vector species	22	5%
<b>Kennel:</b> Inspections of permitted kennels in Orange County	8	2%
<b>Nuisance:</b> Investigations of animals creating a public nuisance	47	10%
<b>Other:</b> Activities that do not fall into other categories	17	4%
<b>Owned:</b> Activities related to owned animals (e.g. surrenders)	24	5%
<b>Protective Custody:</b> Animals impounded due to owners inability to provide care	0	0%
<b>Stray:</b> Activities related to stray animals (animals without owners, off property, etc)	133	29%
<b>Tethering:</b> Activities related to a tethered animal	9	2%
<b>Trap:</b> Activities related to the trapping of an animal	23	5%
<b>Wildlife:</b> Activities related to wildlife species	40	9%


