





Assistance: AC assistance provided to other agencies	16	3%
Bite: Investigations of bites to humans by dogs, cats, ferrets	80	16%
Canvass: AC dissemination of information to the public	10	2%
Confiscate: Animal impounds due to legal order violation, cruelty, investigation	5	1%
Cruelty: Investigations of animal cruelty	27	5%
Exposure: Investigations of animals, people exposed to rabies vector species	10	2%
Kennel: Inspections of permitted kennels in Orange County	1	0%
Nuisance: Investigations of animals creating a public nuisance	61	12%
Other: Activities that do not fall into other categories	4	1%
Owned: Activities related to owned animals (e.g. surrenders)	31	6%
Protective Custody: Animals impounded due to owners inability to provide care	0	0%
Stray: Activities related to stray animals (animals without owners, off property, etc)	168	34%
Tethering: Activities related to a tethered animal	22	4%
Trap: Activities related to the trapping of an animal	27	5%
Wildlife: Activities related to wildlife species	32	6%


