

Veterinary Health Care Team Update

March 16, 2016

- Resolved cat abscesses
 - All areas were deep cleaned at least 3 times
 - While the exact culprit was never determined, the treatment protocol created worked with little to no issues
- Based on data from previous years, we are decreasing the number of medical euthanasia's for cats with URIs
 - Working on sustaining those numbers with different treatment options
- Increasing diagnostics and treatment for common illnesses in the shelter
 - Techs currently being trained to read cytologies, etc.
 - Dr. McKee performs acupuncture and has started using this treatment as needed
- Heartworm Treatment for dogs
 - Donation line-item in Community Giving Fund has made this possible
 - Since getting the program off the ground this past September, we have treated 14 dogs
 - Started treatment on another 5 dogs that are scheduled for immiticide injections at the beginning of April
 - Still working out minor kinks in the program, but seems to be successful so far
