Solid Waste Convenience Centers accept Household Trash and Bulky Items for disposal. No mattresses or box springs. One load per household per day or weekend limit.

Orange County Residents only.

SALVAGE SHEDS are at each center except Bradshaw Quarry. Bring reusable items in good condition. No clothing, carpet, construction materials or trash. Limit 10 minutes each day or weekend period.

RECYCLE SAME ITEMS AS CURBSIDE (See facing page) **PLUS YOU CAN RECYCLE:**

- **YARD WASTE** Except at Bradshaw Quarry Rd.
- **CLEAN WOOD WASTE** Unpainted, untreated wood
- **TIRES** Limit five per month
- **ELECTRONICS** all computers, TV's, stereos etc.
- **OIL FILTERS**
- **LARGE APPLIANCES** Limit two per load
- **SCRAP METAL**
- **ALL BATTERIES** Automotive and Household
- **ANTIFREEZE**
- **USED MOTOR OIL**

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

Monday – Friday 10 am - 6 pm and Saturdays 8 am - 12 noon.

Paint, pesticides, cleaning chemicals, fluorescent lights and other dangerous, flammable or toxic household items.

Empty, flatten, and recap!

Items must fit loosely in cart; do not bag.
Keep lid closed.
Empty, flatten and fold corrugated cardboard.
Items left on the ground will not be collected.
Keep items clean and dry.
Flatten and recap what you can.

Cart service begins when you receive it.
Have cart to the curb by 7am

Thank you for participating in the rural cart recycling collection program. You may start using your cart as soon as you receive it!

Set your cart out **RIGHT** at the curb. Our recycling trucks have automated arms to lift and empty carts. Improper set out means the cart cannot be properly collected. Thank you for your cooperation, and for recycling!

PLACE YOUR CART AT THE EDGE AND PARALLEL TO THE STREET OR ROAD, UNBLOCKED BY CARS, TREES, OR OTHER OBJECTS.

- Allow 3 feet between your cart, mailboxes, trees and other objects.
- Cart must be set directly at roadside, on the edge of the street.
- Make sure the cart opening is facing the street. Look for arrows on lid.

PLACE ONLY ITEMS LISTED ON THE FRONT OF THIS CARD INSIDE YOUR CART.

- Items must fit loosely inside cart, and the lid must be able to close.
- Do not bag recycling in a plastic trash bag; leave items loose.
- **NC State Law:** Plastic drink bottles and aluminum cans **MUST** be recycled.
- You can recycle non-bottle rigid plastics such as small tubs, cups and buckets #2, #4 and #5. Items must fit inside cart, with lid closed.
- Drink boxes, milk, juice and soup cartons of all types can be recycled.
- Leave the cap on bottles, jars and jugs.
- No pots and pans or other scrap metal in your cart! Bring to Solid Waste Convenience Center instead (see back page).

THIS IS CORRUGATED CARDBOARD AND MUST BE RECYCLED 

- Cut or fold empty corrugated cardboard boxes to fit loosely in cart.
- Collection trucks lift and tip carts automatically – items stuck inside will not get recycled.

DO NOT PLACE PLASTIC BAGS OR GARBAGE INSIDE YOUR RECYCLING CART!

- **NO** plastic bags, bagged recyclables, or garbage in your recycling cart. These items interfere with recycling, and may damage equipment.

IF YOU HAVE A CART PLEASE USE ONLY YOUR CART.

- There will be no combined collection of bins and carts at a single household. Use only your cart and retire your old bins!
- You can keep your old orange bins for household use, or bring them to an OC Solid Waste Convenience Center for recycling or reuse.
- Items left on the ground will not be collected.
- If your cart is damaged or missing through no fault of the household, let us know so we can repair or replace it.
- Using a cart for recycling collection improves route efficiency and driver safety.

DO line up cart parallel to the street.



NOT crooked, away from the street.



DO have cart flush on the edge of the street.

DO have lid opening and metal bar facing the street. LOOK FOR ARROWS ON THE LID.



NOT with the handle facing the street.



DO place cart at least three feet away from trees, mailboxes, or other objects.



NOT too close to other objects.
