ORANGE COUNTY, NC (October 31, 2016)—The Orange County Department on Aging and the Project EngAGE Senior Resource Team wants to know, *Are you Planning to Die?*

Community members, caregivers, medical and hospice workers, and religious leaders are invited to share your thoughts and experiences on death and dying on Thursday, November 17, from 4:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. at the Seymour Center in Chapel Hill.

We want to hear your personal story. Were your loved one's wishes honored? What went well and what didn't. Would you do anything differently if you could do it over again? Sharing your story, and learning about others' experiences will allow us to develop a deeper understanding of what it really takes to die with dignity and choice.

Participants are asked to limit their presentation to five minutes so that everyone's story may be heard.
