Medicare Limited Income Newly Eligible Transition Program (LI-NET)

Immediate prescription drug coverage for people with Medicare who are at the pharmacy counter and qualify for Extra Help, but aren't enrolled in a Medicare Pt. D plan. If a pharmacy has reasonable assurance that a person is eligible for Medicaid or Extra Help the pharmacy can submit a LI-NET claim.
