SAME DAY REGISTRATION

Same Day Voter Registration is available during the Early Voting period at all Early Voting sites. **If doing Same-Day Registration, one must bring a valid form of ID (It does not need to be a photo id), and must vote during Early Voting rather than on Election Day.**

By-Mail Voter Registration Deadline is: Friday, April 13th, 5:00 p.m.
Application must be delivered to the Board of Elections by 5:00 p.m. or must be postmarked by 5:00 p.m.
