Curbside recycling is collected weekly in **BLUE ROLL CARTS** by Orange County Solid Waste: **(919) 968-2788** or email recycling@orangecountync.gov



Plastic bottles and jugs (ALL plastic bottles can be recycled)



Glass bottles and jars



Plastic tubs, cups and buckets #2, #4 and #5 only



Steel and aluminum cans, foil



All paper: junk mail, newspapers, magazines, clean pizza boxes, single layer cardboard



Cartons and drink boxes



Corrugated Cardboard is banned from the trash and **MUST** be recycled. Empty, flatten, and place **LOOSELY** inside cart.

- **NO plastic bags or bagged recycling in the blue carts. Leave your recycling loose and free!**
- **NO food or liquids!**
- **Recyclables should be clean and empty.**
- **NO styrofoam or other garbage.**

- Carts should be at the curb with lid opening facing the street.
- Cart placement should be safe for pedestrians and vehicles.
- Carts should not be blocked by cars, mailboxes or other objects.
- Do not leave items on the ground or on top of carts-- only materials placed inside carts will be collected.

Recycling should be out by 7am and removed from the curb by 7pm on your collection day. Failure to do so can result in a \$25 per day fine.

Recycle batteries, electronics and other "hard to recycle" items at Orange County Waste and Recycling Centers.

Fluorescent lightbulbs, paint, pesticides, cleaning products, flammable liquids and other chemicals can be taken to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection at 1514 Eubanks Rd.

Household trash is collected weekly in **GREEN ROLL CARTS** by Chapel Hill Public Works:

- Trash carts should be at the curb by 6:00 a.m.
- All garbage must be inside a tied bag, inside the cart.
- **DO NOT** put the following materials in the trash cart:

Liquids	Rocks	Gas
Dirt	Paint	Ashes
Recyclables	Electronics	Yard Waste
- **No** corrugated cardboard in your green trash cart. Recycle it instead. See other side about recycling.
- Place sharp objects in a puncture resistant container.



Yard Waste is collected in **BROWN ROLL CARTS**. They can be purchased from Chapel Hill Public Works for \$50.

Loose leaves, pine straw, grass and twigs should be placed at the curb inside the cart, or in a rigid container or paper bags. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**

- Leaves and pine straw can be collected loose mid-October through mid-February only.

All carts must be removed from the curb on collection day by 7:00 p.m. Failure to do so can result in a \$25 per day fine.

- Carts should be at the curb with lid opening facing the street.
- Cart placement should be safe for pedestrians or vehicles.
- Carts should not be blocked by cars, mailboxes or other objects.
- Do not leave items on the ground or on top of carts-- only materials placed inside carts will be collected.

Bulky Items: Furniture, appliances, grills, bookshelves, carpeting, mattresses, computers, televisions, etc. are collected from the curb for a fee upon request.

- Call 919-969-5100 to request bulky item collection **BEFORE** items are placed at the curb.
- Fee: \$15 for up to three items, \$5 for each additional
- Payment by cash, credit card, or check is accepted.
