

## **Navigation and Transportation Work Group Census Data on Older Adults and Transportation**

### **Transportation to Work in Orange County**

- **2006-2010 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates**
  - In 2006-2010, an estimated 5.5% of the workforce in Orange County were adults ages 60-64 and 3.1% were adults age 65 and over.
  - How adults age 60 and over got to work in 2006-2010:
    - 71.3% drove alone
    - 8.1% carpooled
    - 2.7% used public transportation (excluding taxi)
    - 2.6% walked
    - 1.3% used a taxi, motorcycle, bicycle, or other means
    - 13.9% worked at home

### **Tenure by Vehicle Availability by Age of Householder in Orange County**

- **2006-2010 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates**
  - Of an estimated 6,139 homes owned by adults age 65 and over in 2006-2010:
    - Approximately 3.7% did not have a vehicle available
    - Approximately 96.3% had 1 or more vehicles available.
  - Of an estimated 1,685 homes rented by adults age 65 and over in 2006-2010:
    - Approximately 33.4% did not have a vehicle available
    - Approximately 66.3% had 1 or more vehicles available
