Glossary:

Group quarters: Includes people not living in households such as in nursing homes, correctional facilities, group homes, hospice, rehab, military quarters, etc.

Household: A household includes all the people who occupy a housing unit as their usual place of residence

Labor force: Includes people in the civilian labor force, employed or unemployed

Median Age: This measure divides the age distribution into two equal parts. One half of the population fall below the median value and one half above the median value
