SELECT COMMUNITY SPAY/NEUTER STATS

- *Comparison of Q1-3 2012 versus Q1-3 2013*
 - *Vouchers issued: 403 in 2012 versus 376 in 2013 (<7%)*
 - *Vouchers redeemed: 348 in 2012 versus 280 in 2013 (<25%)*
- *Uptick in vouchers issued in Q2 & Q3 2013*
 - *Q3: 144 in 2012 versus 143 in 2013*
 - *Q2: 124 in 2012 versus 138 in 2013*
 - *Q1: 135 in 2012 versus 95 in 2013*
- *Why?*
 - *Bi-lingual door hangers courtesy of Animalkind*
 - *Every door direct mail mailings*
- *Spay & Neuter Day, November 6*
 - *21 cats and dogs are already registered*
 - *30 to 33 cats and dogs is the goal*

SELECT YTD SUMMARY STATS

- *Comparison of Q1-3 2012 versus Q1-3 2013*
 - *Fewer intakes: 2759 in 2012 versus 2542 in 2013 (< 8%)*
 - *More live releases: 1681 in 2012 (63%) versus 1745 in 2013 (71) (>4%)*
- *Cats*
 - *Parity between intakes: 1188 in 2012 versus 1182 in 2013*
 - *Parity in live releases: 673 in 2012 versus 669 in 2013 (<1%)*
 - *Near parity in euthanasia: 397 in 2012 versus 388 in 2013 (<2%)*
- *Dogs*
 - *Fewer intakes: 1494 in 2012 versus 1287 in 2013 (<14%)*
 - *More lives releases: 948 in 2012 versus 1008 in 2013 (>6%)*
 - *Sharp decrease in euthanasia: 523 in 2012 versus 253 in 2013 (<52%)*
