

“surplus pets”


Lowered animal

Less euthanasia


Controlling costs of

Animals Admitted: 2005-2012




Animal Outcomes: 2005-2012




"Live Release" animals include animals that were recovered by their owner, adopted, or transferred to a placement partner organization (rescue group)
