 - Euthanasia
 - EBI only
 - Euthanasia is performed by Certified Euthanasia Technicians
 - More specialized procedures
 - Amputations
 - Dentals
 - FHO (Femoral Head Ostectomy)
 - Addition of 4th Veterinary Health Care Technicians
 - Two will work Saturday and 1 Sunday
- Rabies Clinics
 - Added two this year to our usual 12 for a total of 14 clinics this year
 - 979 YTD
 - Expect to vaccinate 1250 this year
- Partnerships with local vets
 - Concerted and ongoing outreach efforts, e.g., clinic photos
 - Tymberline and Legion Road sold to VCA (building relationship)
 - Donations from private practices both monetary and medical items
 - Donation of services
 - TVRH- Boarded Surgeon
 - Local Practices- Radiographs
- Trupanion
 - Pet insurance for newly adopted animals
 - Coming soon
- Microchip implantation for reclaimed animals
