

**Public Meeting Concerning the Investigation of the Former
Hillsborough Landfill
October 2nd, 7:00 pm
Town of Hillsborough Police Substation
501 Rainey Avenue, Hillsborough**

On Monday, October 2nd at 7:00 pm, staff from Orange County and the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) will present information to the Fairview Community Watch organization concerning the start of an investigation of the former Hillsborough Landfill. This meeting, which is open to the public, will be held at the Town of Hillsborough Police Substation located in the Fairview community of Hillsborough at 501 Rainey Avenue.

The former municipal landfill, located north of Torain Street in the Fairview community, operated from 1941 until 1975. Orange County and DEQ are planning to begin the first phase of a project soon to determine the nature and extent of the waste materials that were buried at the site. The project will include analysis of air, surface water and groundwater conditions at the site, as well as assess potential impacts to receptors in the area, including locating and possibly sampling groundwater wells in the vicinity of the site.
