



Wall Color

Bone white [between a bright white and an Ivory]

Signage as art element on walls

Painted in brand colors; English and Spanish
Tagline under the check out counter



New Wall

Paint the same as other wall color
Add a strip at the top in the brand blue
Add the logo to the wall

Frosted Glass on Windows

Frost the bottom portion of the glass on the check out windows to approximately eye-level

Baseboard

Choose a color that is as close to the floor color as possible

Counter laminate

Re-laminate check out counter with orange laminate

Accent Wall Color
Blue, orange or lime green from logo

Signage as art element on walls
Directional signage painted here pointing to check out counter– Like words above counter



Hand Rails
Painted in blue accent color

New Curtains
Nice curtain that is similar in color to wall with addition of trim to match logo colors




Floor Graphics








WHY SIT-STAND?



An American Cancer Society study of 120,000 adults, published in 2010, suggests that the more people sit, the **shorter their average life span**.

What's more, the findings were independent of physical activity level such as with people who exercise outside of work.


RESULTS


