



## Leadership Team

The mission of the Orange County Partnership to End Homelessness (OCPEH) is to work collaboratively to end and prevent homelessness in Orange County. The Partnership's Leadership Team is the governing body of the Partnership and provides leadership to its work.

The Leadership Team comprises representatives from each of the elected bodies of the four (4) local governments (Orange County, Chapel Hill, Carrboro and Hillsborough) as well as a broad representation of other members of the community including homeless service providers, local businesses, developers/homebuilders, funders, faith-based communities, UNC-CH, UNC Hospitals, formerly homeless individuals and other homelessness stakeholders.

Members of the OCPEH Leadership Team are volunteers who wish to provide leadership to help achieve its mission, live and/or work in Orange County and are at least eighteen (18) years of age. Most members participate on one or more subcommittees and are actively engaged in helping to accomplish the work of the Partnership. Members serve two-year terms beginning January 1 and meet monthly – typically first Wednesdays of each month, 5:30-7:00pm, at the S. Human Services Center on Homestead Rd. in Chapel Hill.
