ORANGE COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY ANNOUNCES EXPANDED HOURS AND SERVICES *Changes Take Effect July 1, 2013*

ORANGE COUNTY, NC (June 20, 2013)— The Orange County Public Library (OCPL) will increase its Main Library hours of operation and extend loan periods on select materials beginning Monday, July 1, 2013.

The OCPL Main Library in Hillsborough, which already operates 7 days a week, will be open the following hours:

- Monday through Thursday: 9:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
- Friday and Saturday: 9:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m.
- Sunday: 12:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

“We are pleased to extend service to the public by four hours a week,” said OCPL Director Lucinda Munger. “The Main Library will be open one hour earlier Fridays and Saturdays. And we are especially pleased to add two hours of service on Sundays, one of our busiest days.”

OCPL will also offer new lending terms on DVDs and Kindle e-readers.

Library customers will now be able to borrow as many as five DVDs at a time (up from three.) The lending period will be increased to seven days (up from three.)

Kindle e-readers, available at the Main Library, will now be available for renewal. Previously, the library did not renew Kindles at the end of the 3-week lending period.

“DVDs are incredibly popular with library customers,” said Munger, “and as we continue to grow this collection, we are delighted to increase the lending period. Customers are encouraged to use the Express Checkout station located on the Main Library’s 2nd floor to borrow these and other library items.”
