The following documents are available at the OCPL Main Library's second floor:

- 1040 forms and instructions
- 1040A forms and instructions
- 1040EZ instructions
- Schedule A (itemized deductions)
- Schedule B (interest and ordinary dividends)
- Schedule SE (self-employment tax)

Patrons can also print up to 10 pages of any tax forms free of charge at the library.

Library staff cannot give any tax advice or information. However, they are happy to assist in locating needed tax forms and instructions.

The Orange County Department of Aging's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) provides free federal and state income tax preparation to eligible individuals with low-to-middle incomes, regardless of age or county of residence.
