Why: The Town of Hillsborough adopted a Future Land Use Plan in March 2013 for its planning jurisdiction and some additional areas of Orange County's planning jurisdiction. These additional areas of County jurisdiction, which are being jointly planned, are located within the Town's Urban Service Boundary for its public water and/or sewer services and generally located around the Town's fringe. The purpose of the open house is to help inform the public of the joint land use planning process and next steps.

Since this will be an open house meeting, feel free to come anytime during the specified times to receive information, discuss the project with staff, and learn about the upcoming County public hearing scheduled for September 9, 2013.
