ORANGE COUNTY LIBRARY ISSUES STRATEGIC PLANNING SURVEY

ORANGE COUNTY, NC (March 22, 2013)—The Orange County Main Library is inviting feedback from the public regarding the first draft of the library’s strategic plan.

A survey will be conducted until April 10, 2013, and will take a few minutes to complete. The survey is available online at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/orangecountylibrarystrategicplansurvey>

Hard copies are being mailed to 1,000 randomly-selected County households and will also be available at the Main Library in Hillsborough.

“This is an effort to ensure the County is meeting the community’s library needs,” said Library Director Lucinda Munger. “The public’s input plays a vital role in developing a plan that will take the library from where it is today to where the community envisions it for the future.”

The draft strategic plan was developed from surveys, interviews and community forums conducted in October 2012. A final draft of the plan will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners in May 2013.
