### Documentation you will need to enroll:

1. Social Security Numbers (or document numbers for legal immigrants) of everyone in your household who needs coverage
2. Dates of birth of all members of your household
3. Employer and income information for every member of your household who needs coverage (example: pay stubs or W-2 forms)
4. Policy numbers for any health insurance plans currently covering members of your household
5. A completed [Employer Coverage Tool](#) for every job-based plan that you or someone in your household is eligible for. (Available at [healthcare.gov](http://healthcare.gov))
6. A list of current medications for you and members of your household.
7. The contact information of your healthcare providers you want to continue seeing.
8. A working e-mail address (if you have one. If not, one will be created for you).
