Orange County Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) Public Input Session – First Draft UDO Released for Input



Who: The Orange County Planning and Inspections Department is inviting the public to attend an upcoming Public Input Session.

What: Orange County is in the process of preparing a Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) and has completed its first draft. A UDO compiles property development regulations into one cross-referenced document. Examples of existing ordinances to be included in the UDO are: zoning, subdivision, flood damage, and erosion control.
