Responds to emergency and non-emergency medical and traumatic situations. Provides paramedic-level assessment and patient care. Maintains written and computer based documentation of patient encounters. Manages EMS resources for appropriate scene operations. This is a 12 or 24-hour rotating shift position, which includes nights, weekends and holidays.

Requirements: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school and at least 2 years emergency medical experience as a Paramedic or experience in a related medical profession. Must possess and maintain a driver's license valid in the State of North Carolina and Emergency Medical Technician certification at the Paramedic level. Prefer two years emergency paramedic field experience functioning independently in a high volume service, experience in scene management and patient assessment, and ACLS, PALS and or BTLS certifications.
