The Health Department has an immediate opening for a Senior Public Health Educator. This position will be responsible for the administration and coordination of Healthy Carolinians of Orange County Coalition. Collects and analyzes health data including oversight of the community assessment every 4 years and annual State of the County Health Reports. Implements and evaluates Healthy Carolinians subcommittee health plans; prepares health reports, including qualitative and quantitative data; grant writing, media facilitation, marketing and promotion of coalition initiatives, and preparation of re-certification documents. The individual in this role must represent Orange County Healthy Carolinians on appropriate committees and other partnerships. He or she will supervise students from area Universities participating in projects and coalition initiatives. Works with other health-related initiatives in the county to facilitate communication; coordination of efforts and efficient use of county resources.

**Work Schedule:** Regular Work Schedule: M-F 8-5. Weekend and evening hours will be required for community events, meetings and response to public health incidents.

**Requirements:** Requires any combination of education and experience equivalent to a Bachelor's degree and two to four years of experience in health education. May be required to obtain additional certification(s) as deemed necessary by supervisor.
