Description: Consolidated Public Safety answering point. Answers 9-1-1 communications line and monitors emergency response agencies. Dispatches law enforcement, fire, EMS, rescue and support agencies for Orange County and its municipalities. Performs record keeping tasks of services required. Maintains current knowledge of service areas and computer system. This is a 12-hour rotating shift position, which includes days, evening, nights, weekends, holidays and in-service training.

Requirements: Requires any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school and one year public safety communications experience. Prefer knowledge of dispatch function and the Orange County area and previous rotating shift work. Within the first six months of employment, must: 1) possess and maintain a Division of Criminal Information (DCI) certificate issued by the N.C. Department of Justice; 2) obtain CPR certification; 3) pass the Basic Telecommunicator Training course and obtain certification through the North Carolina Sheriffs' Commission, and; 4) pass and maintain national and state Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) certification. Must be 21 years of age to be considered for employment.

**Pre-employment drug testing, physical examination and complete reference, background and criminal history checks will be required prior to employment.*
