Orange Community Recycling

Orange Community Recycling, a division of Orange County Solid Waste Management Department, offers curbside recycling to residents of Carrboro, Chapel Hill, Hillsborough and 70% of the unincorporated parts of the County. Recycling is available at over 95% of apartment complexes as well as at each of the five Orange County Solid Waste Convenience Centers and five 24-hour Recycling Drop-off Sites.

 Per section or single wide \$200.00



Clean Wood Waste
 Per ton (1-ton minimum charge) \$18.00
 Pick-up Truck / Van / Trailer Load* \$ 8.00
 (under 1000 pounds)

Stumps and Land Clearing Waste
 Per ton (1-ton minimum charge) \$ 44.00



Vegetative Waste
 Per ton (1-ton minimum charge) \$ 18.00

Tires (any size)
 Residential/commercial tires **No charge**
 Stockpiled tires/No State certification \$ 100.00 per ton



Appliances (White Goods)
 Commercial white goods must have refrigerant removed prior to disposal **No charge**

Scrap Metal
 Separated, clean loads of scrap metals **No charge**











Oyster Shells
 Separated from any other wastes. **No charge**

*10 feet long/ 1000 lbs. maximum for trailers

All loads must be TARPED
Vehicles must have working TAILGATE

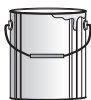
WHAT ABOUT ITEMS BANNED FROM THE LANDFILL?

-  **Aluminum Cans and Plastic Bottles** North Carolina State Law bans aluminum cans and plastic bottles from landfill disposal. Recycling opportunities are available throughout the county.
-  **Asbestos** No commercial asbestos is allowed in Orange County Landfill. Contact Allied Waste Services, Durham, NC (919) 991-1000 or First Piedmont Corporation, Chatham, VA (800) 476-6780. Residential asbestos must call ahead for instructions.
-  **Automotive Fluids** Antifreeze, motor oil, and used oil filters can be recycled at all five Orange County Solid Waste Convenience Centers. Kerosene, transmission fluid, gear oil, diesel fuel, and heating oil (each in a separate container) can be recycled with used motor oil. NO other types of fuels are allowed.
-  **Batteries of all types** Lead acid, rechargeable and dry-cell batteries can all be recycled at all five Solid Waste Convenience Centers and at the Household Hazardous Waste Collection.
-  **Electronics** Non-residential data-carrying electronics such as computers and peripherals, televisions, radios, fax machines, printers and telephones can be recycled at the Orange County Landfill at no charge during normal hours of operation.
-  **Hazardous Waste** Residents and businesses that generate small quantities (less than 220 pounds per month) of hazardous waste can bring it to the Hazardous Waste Collection, Monday-Friday 10am-6pm and Saturdays 7:30am-12:00 noon at the Orange County Landfill.
-  **Liquids** No liquids are permitted at the Orange County Landfill.
-  **Tires** Up to 5 tires of all sizes are allowed per visit without scrap tire hauler certification.

Dispose of Hazardous Waste Responsibly








Bring automotive, lawn, garden and pool chemicals, household cleaners, paints, solvents, fluorescent lights, anything that might be hazardous to the HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

No explosive, medical or radioactive wastes.

Businesses that generate small quantities (less than 220 pounds per month) are **welcome**. Businesses with more than fifty pounds of material or more than fifty paint cans call for an appointment (919) 968-2788

-  **Clean Wood Waste*** Scrap dimensional lumber (2" X 4" type), mill ends, oriented strand board (OSB), pallets, plywood, and wood used in concrete forms with <2" diameter residual plaster/concrete attached. Construction nails, bolts and screws in reasonable amounts are OK. **NO cross-ties, landscaping timbers, masonite, painted or stained wood, telephone poles, treated wood, or wood with tar or roofing materials.**
-  **Corrugated Cardboard*** Cardboard dumpsters are available at recycling drop-off sites and at the Orange County Landfill for businesses that generate 50 boxes per week or less. **Boxes must be flattened with packing material removed. No pizza boxes or wax-coated boxes.**
-  **Oyster Shells** other bi-valve shells are OK. Must be separate from other wastes. Businesses only.
-  **Scrap Metal*** Including but not limited to cast iron tubs, aluminum gutters and siding, bedsprings, metal pipe, steel studs, tin roofing and other items containing significant amounts of metal.
-  **White Goods** (refrigerators, stoves, water heaters, washers, dryers, etc.) **and Scrap Metal** are collected for recycling in a separate area. White goods from non-residential sources must have any refrigerant removed prior to disposal.
-  **Vegetative Waste*** Brush, grass, leaves, and logs no larger than 12" in diameter or 10' long. No plastic bags, trash, dirt, rocks or stumps.
-  **Stumps and Land Clearing Debris** Logs over 10 feet long or logs over 12 inches in diameter.

**Loads of waste that contain more than 1/3 cubic yard of a concentrated bunch of these banned material are subject to double the tipping fee. Loads of 50% or more of these banned materials may pay an additional penalty of \$400. The Orange County Landfill offers reduced tip fees for these materials if separated prior to disposal.*
