

Solid Waste Advisory Board Resolution

A Resolution Commending the Work of the Solid Waste Management Department and Recommending no Further Cuts in the Solid Waste Budget for 2010-11

Whereas the Orange County Solid Waste Management Department provides a vital, necessary and well-used set of waste management and recycling services, and

Whereas cuts in the budget for 2009-2010 resulted in cuts in service especially in operational hours at Solid Waste Convenience Centers, and

Whereas the Department continues to experience demands to increase services, hours of operation and types of materials to be recycled, and

Whereas the Department has been able to increase some recycling and waste reduction opportunities despite recent budgetary cutbacks, and

Whereas the County is committed to meeting its waste reduction goals while providing a high level of service.

Therefore be it now resolved that the Solid Waste Advisory Board recommends that no further cuts in the Solid Waste Management Budget be made for the FY 2010-11 budget and all current services be maintained.
