## **Public Comment Instructions**

### **Public Comment – Written (for the items on the agenda above)**

Members of the public may provide written public comment by submitting it to the [ocbocc@orangecountync.gov](mailto:ocbocc@orangecountync.gov) email address up to 24 hours after the close of the public hearing.

When submitting the comment, include the following:

- The date of the meeting
- The agenda item (example: Item #2) you wish to comment on
- Your name, address, email and phone number

The Orange County Board of Commissioners, County Manager, County Attorney and Clerk to the Board, will be copied on all of the emails that are submitted.

### **Public Comment – Verbal (for the items on the agenda above)**

Members of the public submitted requests to speak by the 3:00 PM deadline on December 15, 2020, the date the Board opened the public hearing for the proposed Efland Station development. Due to the large number of individuals signed-up to speak and the Board not wishing to extend into late hours that night when both Board members and the public were less than alert, the public hearing was recessed and continued until Tuesday, January 5, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. The Board also identified Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. as an additional date and time for continuing the public hearing.

Individuals who were registered and did not get a chance to speak on December 15, 2020 will have the opportunity to provide their comments on January 5, 2021, or January 12, 2021.

Prior to the January 5, 2021 virtual meeting, email notifications with participation instructions will be sent to the next 45 speakers for the January 5, 2021 virtual meeting. Those next 45 speakers will be emailed a participant link to be able to make comments during the live meeting. Speakers may use a computer (with camera and/or microphone) or phone to make comments.

The public speaker's audio and video will be muted until the BOCC gets to the respective agenda item(s). Individuals who have pre-registered will then be brought into the public portion of the meeting one at a time.

While no more names will be added to the list to speak, anyone may continue to provide written comments to all Board members by sending an email to [ocbocc@orangecountync.gov](mailto:ocbocc@orangecountync.gov).
