


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POLICIES & PROCEDURES

TO REGISTER

Registrations are processed first-come, first-served. Registration will only be processed online or via phone. No in-person registration.

Registration will continue until one week prior to the start of a program or a program reaches maximum enrollment (whichever comes first). Fees must be paid in full.

To register by phone, call 919.245.2660 during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

REFUND POLICY

Fees are 100% refundable when the program is cancelled by the Department. If requested prior to seven days in advance of the reservation date or first program date, a full refund less a \$5 administrative fee will be given. If requested between two and six days of the reservation date or first program date, a 50% refund less \$5 will be given. No refund will be given if requested less than two days before reservation date or first program date. No administrative fee is charged if a household credit is accepted.

MINIMUM/MAXIMUM

In order to ensure the best possible program, activities have minimum and maximum enrollments. Registration may close before the registration deadline if a program reaches its maximum. Likewise, programs may be cancelled if the minimum is not met.

PHOTO POLICY

Orange County Recreation reserves the right to photograph and publish photographs of participants for publicity purposes. Photographs may also be shared with the program instructors.

REQUIREMENTS

Participants will need a home computer or tablet with microphone capabilities and a web camera. Participants will also need reliable internet access to participate in live, real-time, web-based programming. All other supplies and equipment will be provided.

Some programs will require parent participation or support. Parent availability is strongly encouraged for all programs to assist with any connectivity troubleshooting.

We will be sanitizing all supplies as they are put together, but we encourage participants to again wipe them down when bringing them inside. 


