Know the facts. The COVID-19 vaccines:

- ✓ **Protect you, your family, and the people in your community** from getting COVID-19. Even if you have had COVID-19, it is important to get the shot.
- ✓ **May cause mild, temporary, side effects** like a sore arm, headaches, fever, or fatigue. These side effects are signs that the vaccine is working.
- ✓ **Are effective, safe and FREE.**
- ✗ **Do not** change your DNA.
- ✗ **Do not** contain fetal cells, animal products, or microchips.
- ✗ **Do not** contain the COVID-19 virus. Vaccines teach your body how to create antibodies that protect you from COVID-19.
- ✗ **Do not** affect your fertility.
