

What's in YOUR medicine cabinet?



Bring any unused or expired medications to prescription drug drop boxes so they are properly disposed of. While it may not seem like a big deal to have medications lying around in the home, it could easily lead down a tragic path of addiction or unintentional poisonings. Take the simple step of disposing of medications!

DROP OFF GUIDELINES

Prescription drug drop boxes are intended for liquid and pill medications that are expired, unused, or unwanted. Liquid medications must remain in original containers. **PLEASE SEAL LIQUID MEDICATIONS IN A CLOSED ZIPLOC BAG.** Pill medications may remain in original containers or be placed in a sealable plastic bag. Do not drop loose pills. Please remember to remove all identifiable information from containers or packages before disposal.

- Over-the-counter medications
- Pet medications



DO NOT DROP

- Bloody or infectious waste
- Hydrogen peroxide
- IV bags
- Needles/Lancets/Syringes
- Personal care products
- Thermometers
