Dear Sports Organizations,

Reservation requests for the fall season (August 1 – October 31) can be submitted after June 1. Reservation requests for the spring season (Mid-March – June 1) can be submitted after January 1. The Soccer.com Center is located at 4701 West Ten Road in Efland. Please review the field layout map prior to submitting requests.

The Soccer.com Center operates two seasons: (1) Fall running August 1 through October 31 and (2) Spring running Mid-March through June 1. Other dates outside of the fall and spring window dates will be considered on an individual basis. The normal Soccer.com Center hours are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday, 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Friday play for tournaments will be considered on a case-by-case basis. When requesting to host a tournament please make sure to review all tournament request documents and submit them separately from regular game play requests.

All organizations will be required to submit a certificate of insurance naming “Orange County Government, PO Box 8181, Hillsborough, NC 27278” as additionally insured prior to receiving any approved field permit.

The materials included with this letter should explain most of the information that will be important for you to know. Please take the time to review all of it, and share pertinent information with your teams, general membership, and partnering sports organizations. Most importantly, please note field marshals will be onsite during the entirety of your field rental. Field benches, goals, trash cans, etc. should not be moved by coaches or an organization’s staff, volunteer, or player without prior approval of the field marshal. Absolutely no painting of fields is permitted. Failure to adhere to this policy may result in forfeiture of future usage at the Soccer.com Center. **Priority consideration is given to Orange County youth and adult soccer groups.**

Please print and complete both the application document and Hold Harmless agreement and return by scan or mail. Once we have reserved dates and times for your use, we will send you notice of fees owed followed by a field permit of your usage.
