County ordinance calculates the number of Solid Waste Programs Fees (SWPF) based on the number of habitable units on a property. The SWPF is calculated based on all units, whether residential or non-residential. For example: on a single parcel there is a single-family house and two single-wide mobile homes. The SWPF count for this parcel would be three.
