# How to register

Visit the library anytime starting June 8th to register babies through kids completing 5th grade for Summer Reading! Follow the adventure path from the front doors to the Youth Services desk to get started. Upon registering, participants receive a free book to keep and a reading log to track daily reading minutes.

# What counts?

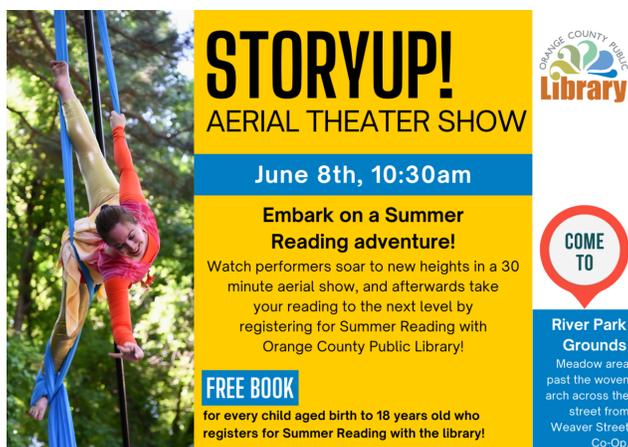
Lots of things count as reading!

- Reading your own book (book, ebook, magazine, comic strip, cereal box, etc.)
- Listening to an Audiobook
- Having someone read to you
- Watching an online/video Storytime or Read Aloud

## Which programs are for me?

While the library's family programs are open to all ages, many programs are designed for a specific age or grade range. Establishing age and grade ranges allows us to plan programs that are appropriate for each range of child development, maintain quality in our programming, and promote fairness to all. For all of our Summer Reading programs, children should attend the program for the grade level they are currently in or the grade level they just finished. For example, rising kindergartners will join K-2 Programming after September 2nd.

# For Teens



## How to register

Patrons who have already completed 6th - 12th grade can stop by the upstairs desk to register for Teen Summer Reading. Upon registering, teens will receive a free book and a map themed log to keep track of their reading and volunteering minutes for the summer.



## Track your reading and volunteering!

Teens are invited to use the log to keep track of reading and volunteering minutes from June 8th through July 27th. Throughout the summer when teens visit the library with their log, they can pick a small weekly prize (while supplies last) for each week reported, whether they decide to visit the library weekly or less frequently. Teens can also fill out comment card(s) about books they've read or volunteer activities they've completed to be entered to win one of 3 larger raffle baskets. **Submit your minutes by July 29th.**
