


Guide to the Orange County Roadshow

Clerk to the Board: Get information and assistance with applying for current boards and commissions vacancies.

Civil Rights & Civic Life: Get resources on discrimination protections, language access and accessibility, support for veterans, and upcoming community events that promote civic engagement.

Sheriff's Office: Learn about community outreach initiatives.

Aging: Register for classes and join the Senior Center.

Planning and Inspections: Weigh in on the Land Use Plan 2050, get information on home occupation, fire code, bona fide farms, and active development projects.

Library: Get a library card, learn about outreach services, and register for upcoming programs.

Social Services: Learn how to become a foster parent, apply for public assistance, and get information about employment services.

Animal Services: Learn about how to adopt or foster a pet, sign up for low cost rabies and microchip clinics, and learn about barn cat programs.

Human Resources: Apply for jobs at Orange County.

Housing: Learn about the Longtime Homeowners Assistance program and get information about rental assistance.

Health: Get information about health resources and programs.

Emergency Services: Get information on emergency services, community paramedics, and hands on CPR.

Economic Development: Learn about agriculture and small business grant programs.

Department of Environment, Agriculture, Parks & Recreation (DEAPR): Register for programs and learn about the Orange County Trails Plan.

Criminal Justice Resource Department (CJRD): Get harm reduction materials, assistance with driving license expungement, program information, and resources.

Cooperative Extension: Get information on agriculture programs and food security resources.

Tax: Learn about tax payment options, payment plans, complete tax assistance applications, and learn how property is assessed.

Sustainability: Learn about Orange County's Climate Action Plan, apply for climate action grants, and get tips for living sustainably.

Public Transportation: Get information about transit schedules and transportation information.

Solid Waste: Learn about waste reduction and recycling information.

Visitor's Bureau: Get information about what makes Orange County a great destination.
