


Drakeford Library Complex Buffer Zone

- Zone begins 50 feet from the door to the entrance of the voting place.
- Only service animals are permitted in the campaigning zone.
- The no campaigning buffer zone extends to roadways and is designated in red below.




Chapel of the Cross Buffer Zone

- It is in violation of § 163-166.4 to hinder access, harass others, or campaign in the buffer zone.
- Zone begins 50 feet from the door to the entrance of the voting place.
- Only service animals are permitted in the campaigning zone.
- The no campaigning buffer zone extends to walkways used to access the door to the voting place, roadways, parking spots, the Memorial Garden, and is designated in red below.




Orange Works Buffer Zone

- It is in violation of § 163-166.4 to hinder access, harass others, or campaign in the buffer zone.
- Zone begins 50 feet from the door to the entrance of the voting place.
- The no campaigning buffer zone extends to walkways and sidewalks used to access the door to the voting place and is designated in red below.
- Only service animals are permitted in the campaigning zone.
- The area for campaigning is adjacent to the buffer zone and designated in green below.



Seymour Senior Center

- It is in violation of § 163-166.4 to hinder access, harass others, or campaign in the buffer zone.
- Zone begins 50 feet from the door to the entrance of the voting place.
- Only service animals are permitted in the campaigning zone.
- The no campaigning buffer zone extends to roadways and designated voter parking spots and is designated in red below:
