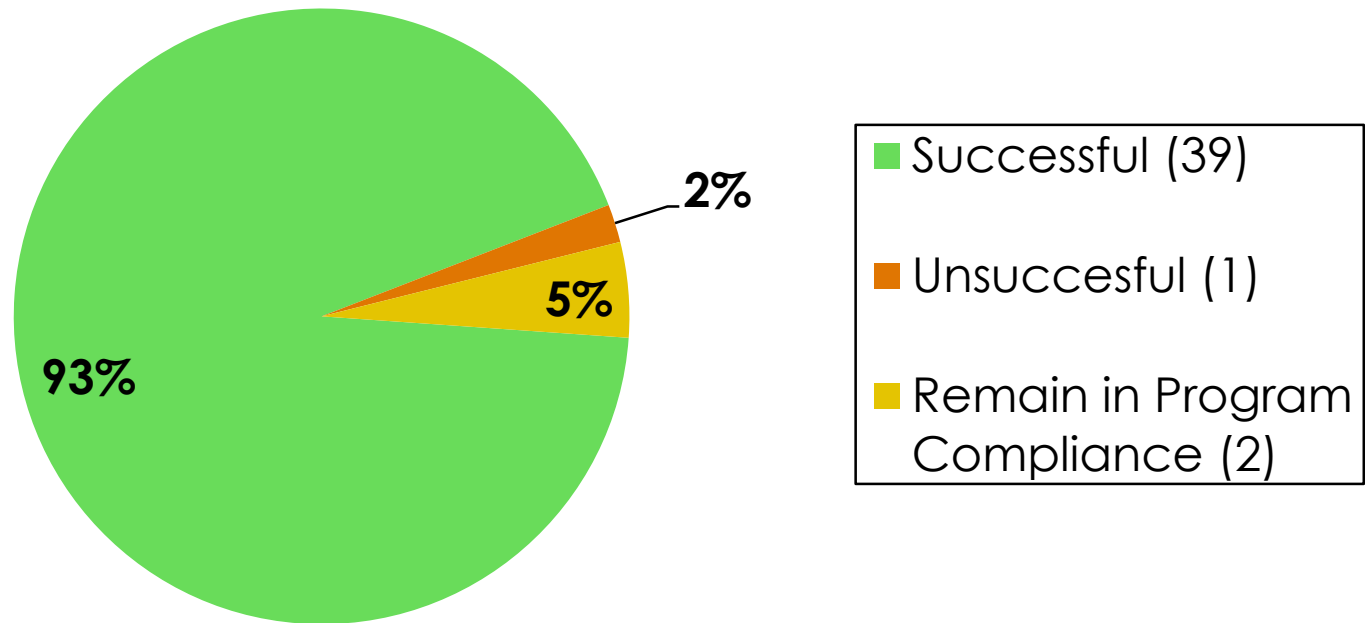

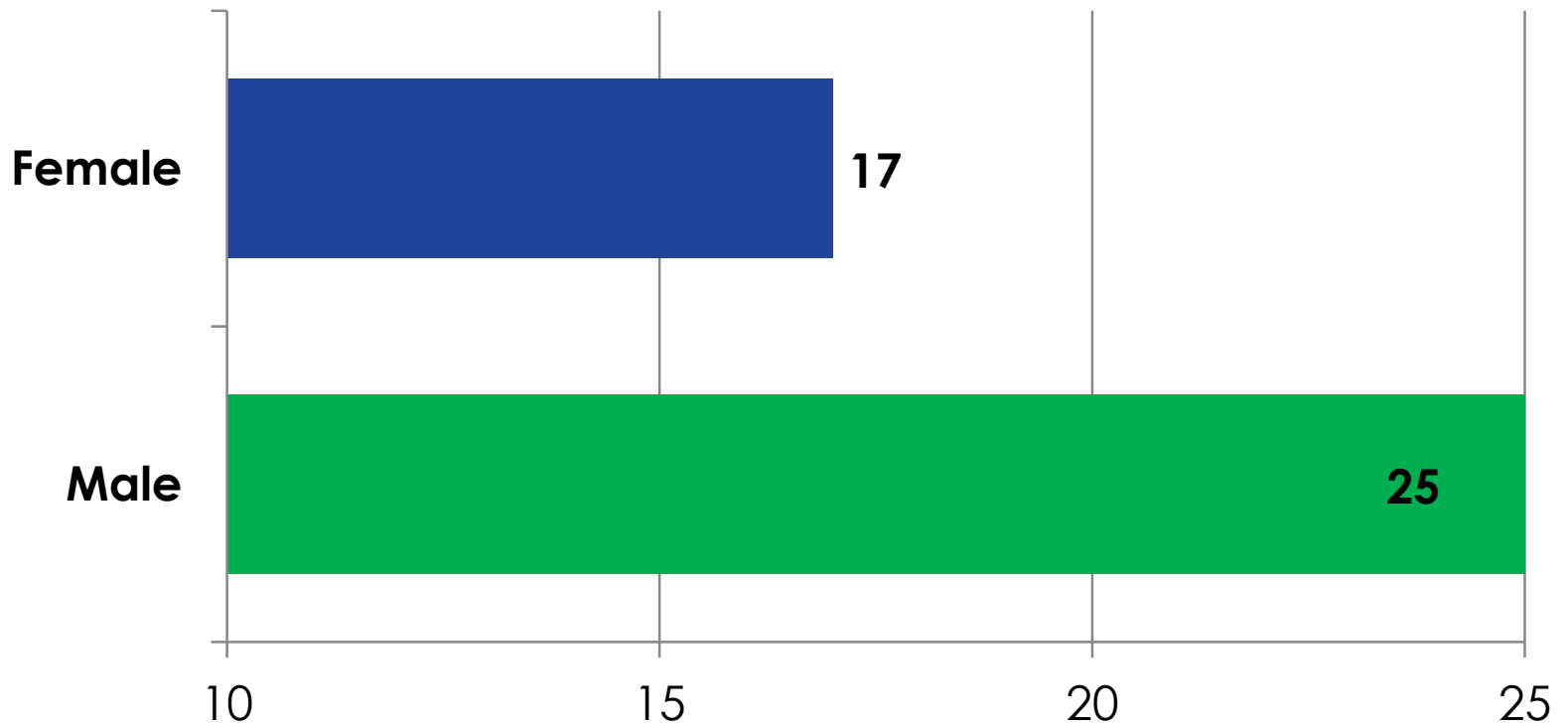
MDP Participant Success/Fail Rate

FY 2017-2018

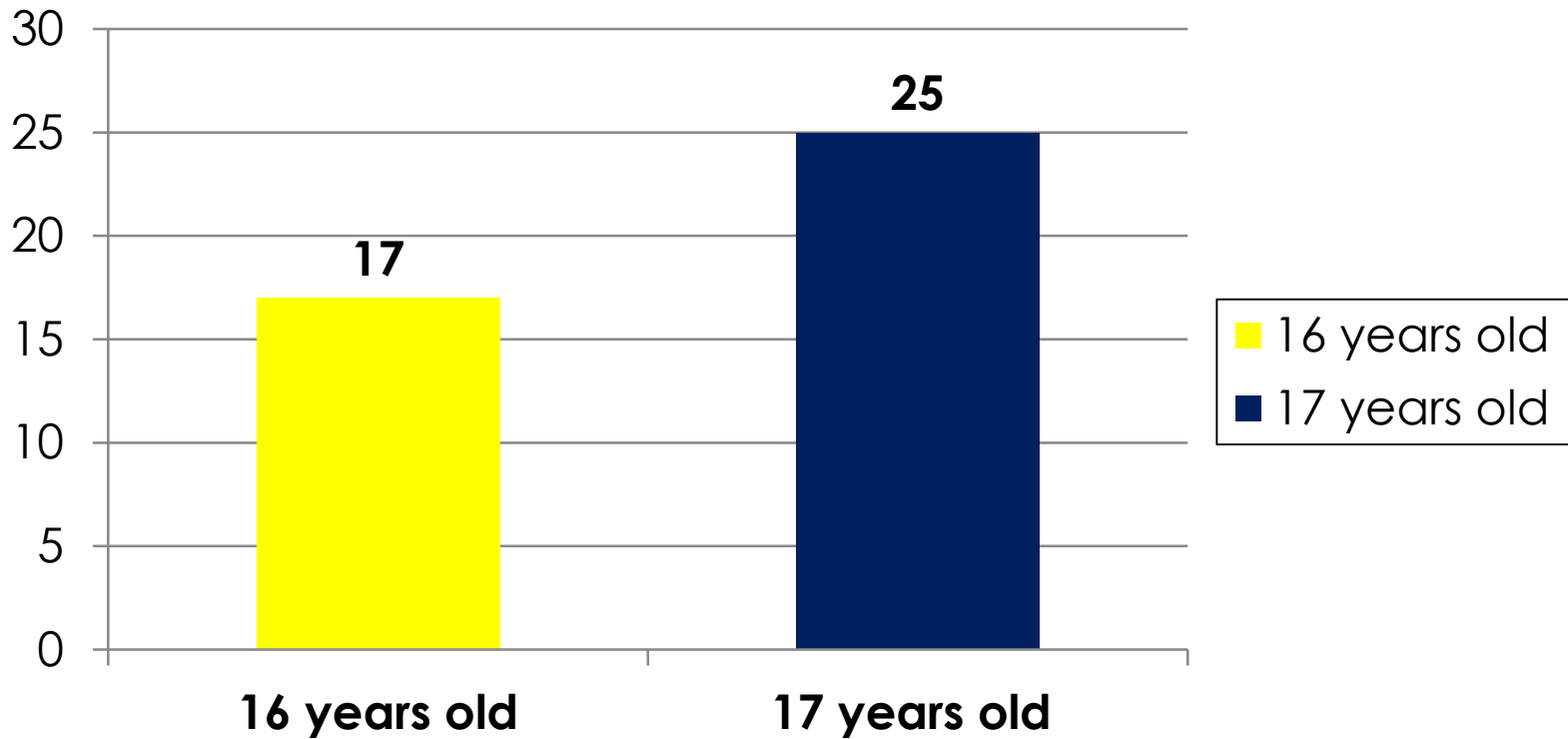


MDP Participants by Gender

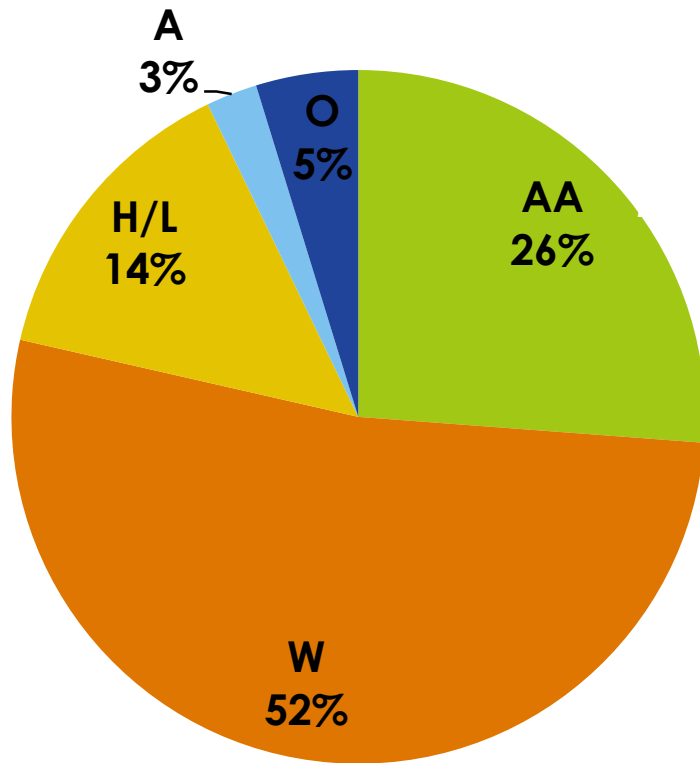


MDP Participant Age FY 2017-2018

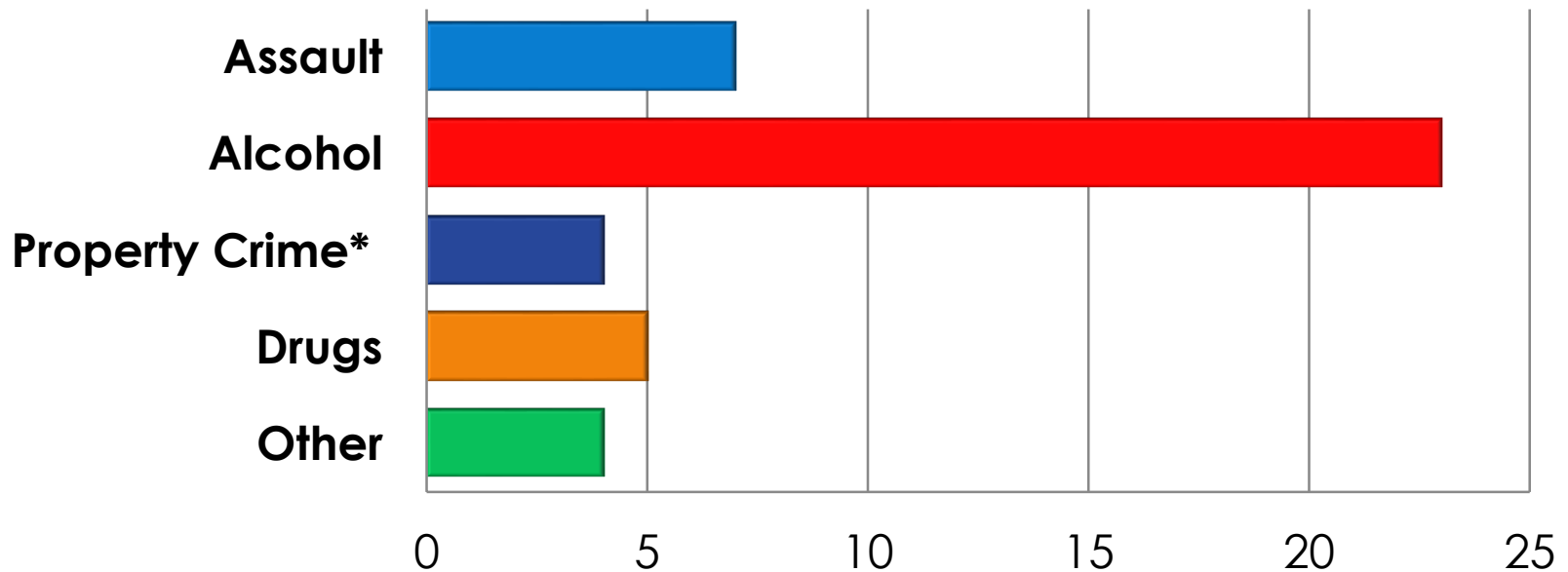

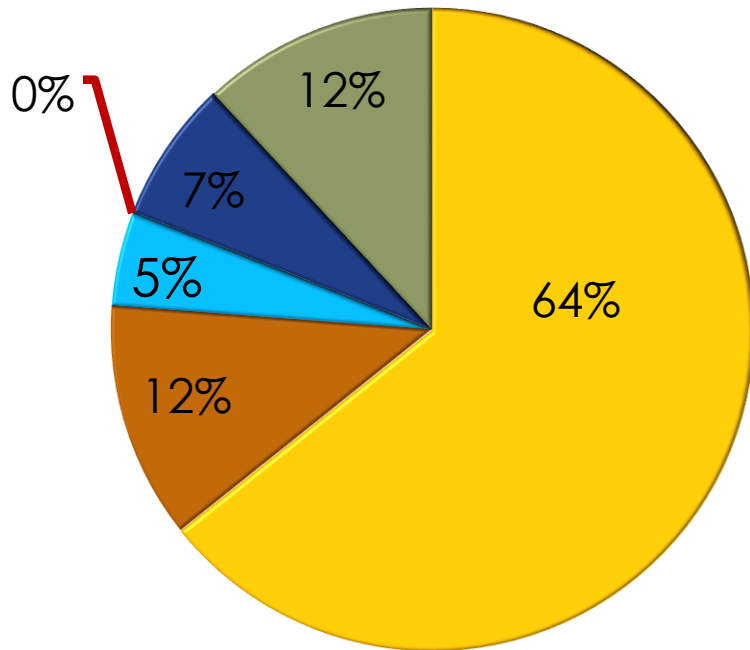

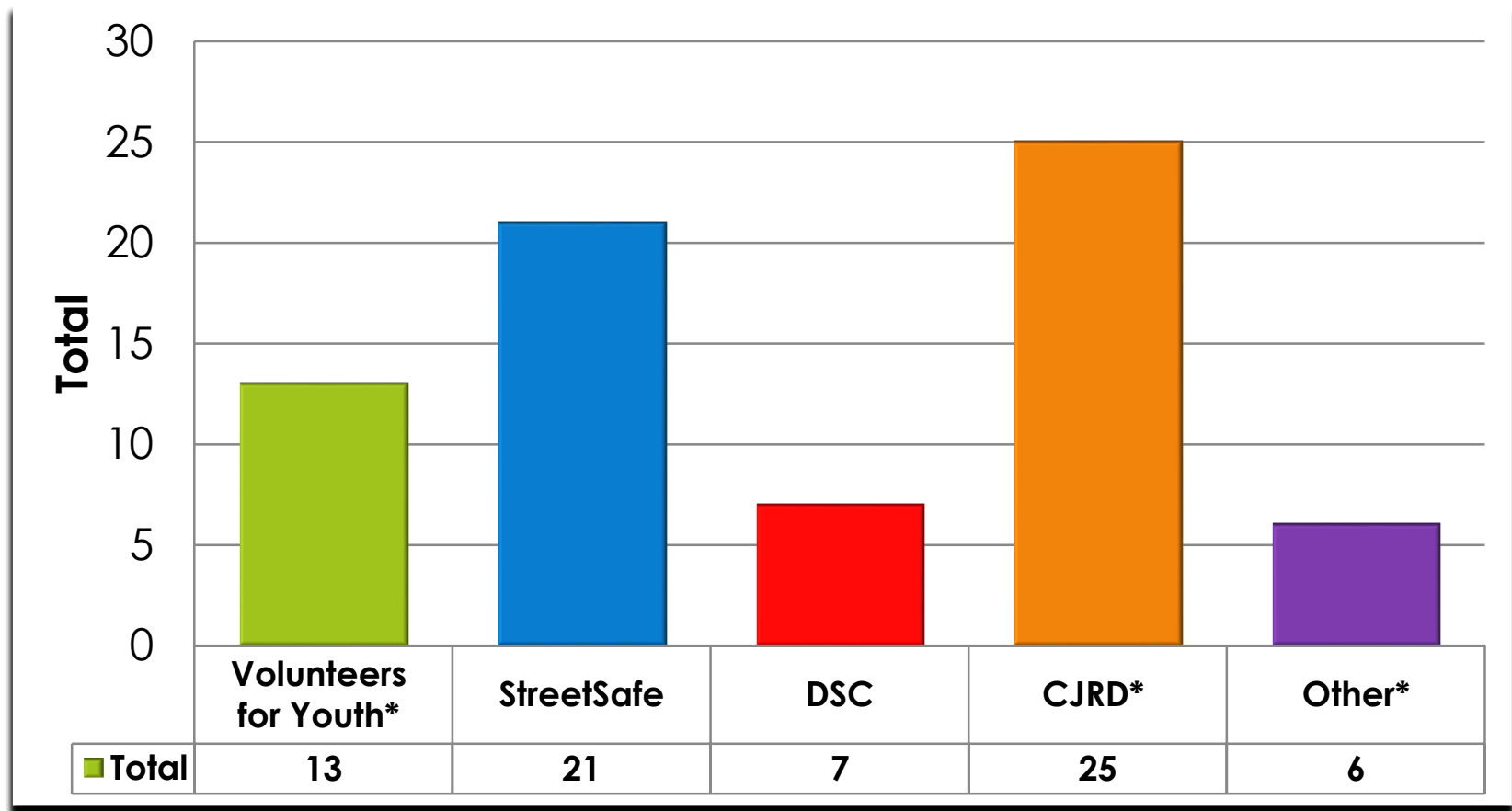
